NSFT – Guenever Pachent (Governor)	
GP confirmed she had attended the 1 <sup>st</sup> meeting of the Black & Minority Ethnic Forum.	

The Forum is for service users but they have to attend a 3 day course to become a member. Healthwatch Suffolk has a Black, Minority & Ethnic group and JD to circulate the dates of those meetings. Healthwatch Suffolk completed a survey with this group and had received over 500 responses on how it affects their mental health. JD confirmed that the MECAN (Suffolk Minority Ethnic Community Action Network) newsletter was available and JD would circulate to everyone.	JD
